A green local authority

Putting a massive effort into environment, Ballerup stands as an active, environment-conscious local authority. Grantoftegård has operated an organic farm with animals, vegetables and grain since 1991. Grantoftegård, one of the largest of its kind in Denmark, is situated in the quaint village of Pederstrup, a short walk from Ballerup Station.

Here you will also find Ballerup Regional Museum and Store Peter's beer garden, offering organic dishes in the high season.



Vibrant cultural life

Cultural life has always held a special place in Ballerup. Dotted around the local authority are more than 100 publicly accessible works of art, which can be toured using our beautifully illustrated art guide. You will be sure to find world-class art and architecture at Egebjerggård, the venue of an international housing exhibition in 1996.

The new urban areas Østerhøj and Søndergård also offer an outstanding integration of art and architecture as well as views of stunning green areas.



Focus on sports

The local authority's more than 300 associations receive solid backing, including excellent facilities for the many active people in Ballerup. Today, competitive sports produce good results in volleyball, teakwondo, tabletennis, boxing and orienteering.

Of late, cycling has acquired superb conditions with the opening of Ballerup Siemens Arena, which has already held a Six-Day Race and the World Championships in track racing with great success.

Access to Ballerup is easy. Four S-train stations and about twenty bus lines sharing a junction in front of Ballerup train station offer good connections with public transportation. Cars too enjoy good connections. Several roads go to Copenhagen, just as Ballerup is directly linked to the large motorway network leading to the rest of Denmark and Europe.

The area surrounding Harrestrup Ådal lends itself to many beautiful walks, short or long. The urban parks in both Skovlunde and Måløv are wonderful breathing spaces, just as the Jonstrupvang area, bordering Hareskoven, will satisfy even the most ardent nature lovers.

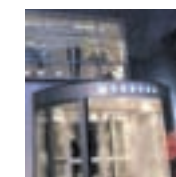
Active business sector

Pursuing an active industrial policy, Ballerup has attracted many large Danish and international companies and currently numbers around 40,000 workplaces.

Lautrup Park between Skovlunde and Ballerup boasts the country's largest concentration of companies in research, administration and high technology, earning the area its obvious name "Denmark's Silicon Valley".
